

Entry to Print Competitions

You will receive an email reminder about a week before a competition off Linda, but reply to Chris our Competition Secretary at leighccsec@gmail.com

Send him the title of your two prints no later than midnight on the Sunday before the competition on the Thursday.

Late entries will not be accepted.

Please print the **title** and your **name** in the top left corner on the back of your card mount; not on the front.

On competition evening, please pick up a label from Chris and stick it in the top left corner on the back of your card mount.

To keep an easy record of all the prints you enter in competitions, make a new Folder in your email account i.e. **!LCC Competition Entries** (putting the ! in front brings it to the top of your Folder list). Then move your reply to Chris from your SENT Folder into it.

Digitally Projected Image Competitions

We use the FFP program (Film Free Program) that involves creating a user name and password to upload your images to their website via the link on ours. It almost instantly resizes your image to fit our projector resolution and emails it to the Projectionist.

The Projectionist, usually Linda, then has the task of importing them into the FFP program on the laptop, and producing score sheets etc. for the competition secretary and webmaster. This all takes time; hence the uploading dates are always between 17 days (the Monday) until midnight 4 days (always the Sunday) before the competition. (With the exception of the Annual Competition) That gives Linda 3 ½ days to prepare. Late entries will not be accepted.

The Projectionist's email account also receives a copy of your user name and password. So if you forget it, don't make a new account, simple email us at leighcameraclub@gmail.com and ask us to retrieve them for you.

If you look at the website on the Digital Uploading page, I have put links to some helpful worksheets:

- **How to resize images to fit the projector**; not essential, but it speeds up uploading from minutes to seconds.
- **Uploading Projected Images to the FFP site**; it also gives you tips on registering.
- The projectionist will always send you an email receipt within 2 days. If you don't hear anything, or wonder if it has been received because you think something went wrong, get in touch before the evening of the competition.
